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Japan Autumn Leaves 9-DayTrip

Tokyo - Mt. Fuji - Hakone - Kyōto - Lake Hamanako - Yokohama - Tokyo

Day 1: USA - Tokyo

Board an international flight bound for Tokyo, eager to begin our Asia vacation. Spend the night aboard as our flight crosses the International Date Line.

Day 2: Arrive Tokyo

Konichiwa! Welcome to Japan! Upon arrival at Narita International Airport, transfer by airport shuttle. The tour representative will Greetings and welcome you at the Hotel. Hotel: Hotel Mystays Premier Narita or similar

Day 3: Tokyo - Mount Fuji - Hakone (Breakfast, Dinner)

After breakfast depart on a full day of sightseeing, beginning at the Five Lakes District dominated by majestic UNESCO listed Mt. Fuji. Enjoy the bird's eye view of the nearby Odawara and Lake Ashi scenic region via the aerial tram Komagatake Ropeway. Enjoy the picturesque view of Mount Fuji in the distance on board a cruise on Lake Yamanakako, a crater lake famous for its views of the famous peak. Lunch will be on your own along one of the many rest stops or service areas on the highways where you can enjoy an abundance of unique eats and snacks that will surprise you. Tonight, relax over a welcome dinner at your hotel in the Hakone Region.

Day 4: Hakone - Kyōto (Breakfast)

Following breakfast, depart the Mount Fuji scenic area and travel to Kyoto, Japan's cultural and artistic center, and the country's capital for over 1,000 years. Kyoto is a sophisticated blend of the ancient and the modern, an urban environment where museums, four star restaurants and active entertainment venues flourish alongside temples, small shops and quiet neighborhoods. Enjoy your free day in Kyoto, take the chance to experience fascinating Kyoto's autumn leaves.

Hotel: El Inn Kyoto or Heian No Mori Kyoto or similar

Day 5: Kyōto - Lake Hamanako (Breakfast)

Today you will be free at your own leisure to explore this historical city. Alternatively, you can join an **optional in-depth tour of Kyoto (\$65)**. And for passengers who do not take the optional tour, coach will pick up at your Hotel at 4:30pm, then transfer to Hamanako. Overnight at Hamanako area (or Toyohashi area). Hotel: Hotel Concorde Hamamatsu or similar

Day 6: Lake Hamanako - Yokohama - Tokyo (Breakfast)

Yokohama highlights include Yamashita Park, a stretch of picturesque gardens set along the main bay front. A gentle stroll through the park serves up stellar views of the city's Harbour area, where a clutch of glass skyscrapers, the Cosmo World Ferris Wheel, and the Landmark Tower gaze down over the bay. It is also home to the Red Brick Warehouse, a waterfront shopping and arts complex set in the port's early-20th-century customs houses.

Other Yokohama's most popular attractions originates from the Chinese immigrants who flocked to the port during the late 1800s, and again after World War II. Today, the city's Chinatown is not only the largest in Japan and Asia, but one of the biggest in the world, making it an essential fixture on visitor itineraries. This warren of streets covers a 2,500 sq. meters, and brims with more than 500 Chinese restaurants, grocery stores and shops, as well as a profusion of food stands. Overnight in Tokyo.

Hotel: Hotel Mystays Tachikawa or similar

Day 7: Tokyo (Breakfast)

Full day tour in Tokyo to explore this dynamic capital city, where over 11 million people live, making the population one of the largest in the world. First stop at Tsukiji Fish Market, then visit the The Ginza district of Tokyo, it is considered the

high fashion center of the city and contains many upscale shops and restaurants. Later to experience the World's Most Impressive Subways "Tokyo Metro" by taking the train from Ginza to Shibuya. In the afternoon, visit Odaiba Kaihin Koen, it is a park along the northwest beach of Odaiba area. It is an artificial beach bent at a right angle, and the total length is about 1.5 km. Then make your way to Tokyo Tower, the communications and observation tower in the Shiba-koen district of Minato. At 332.9 meters (1092 ft), it's the second-tallest structure in Japan. Hotel: Hotel Mystays Tachikawa or similar

Day 8: Tokyo (Breakfast)

Today is free for relax in your hotel, or last minutes shopping. Hotel: Hotel Mystays Tachikawa or similar

Day 9: Tokyo Departure (Breakfast)

Bid farewell to Japan and our tour representative will transfer you to the NRT or HND Airport. Your amazing Japan trip ends.
